

# Packing List

## Documents & Information for Orientation

---

- Class A CDL.
- DOT Physical & Medical Card.
- Driving School Diploma, Grades and Loan Agreement/Contract/Receipt (*discuss eligibility for tuition reimbursement with your recruiter*).
- Social Security Card (make sure your card is an original and the name matches what is on your CDL), Birth Certificate, Resident Alien Card, Permanent Resident Card, Passport, and/or any other documents that may be required for us to legally hire you in accordance with the **I9 form**.
- A Direct Deposit Routing Form, Deposit Slip or Voided Check is required if you wish to elect one of our direct deposit payroll options.
- Dependents' names, social security numbers and birth dates for insurance enrollment.

## Personal Items to Bring

---

Upon completing orientation, you will normally be dispatched. Bring any personal items you may need for yourself or to operate your truck.

- Medical items. Glasses, Hearing Aids, CPAP Machine, Medications (30-day supply).
- Clothing suitable for the different types of weather conditions you may encounter with 7 to 10 changes of clean clothes to maintain good hygiene and a business appropriate appearance. DO NOT pack tank tops, sleeveless shirts, shirts with lewd or offensive print, etc. **The laundry facilities at USA Truck Terminals are free to use.**
- Work boots/shoes. NO flip flops, smooth-soled cowboy boots, sandals, etc. Proper footwear will be required on your road test.
- Personal hygiene items. Soap, deodorant, toothbrush, shower shoes, a couple of towels and washcloths, etc.
- Money to cover evening meals and personal expenses during orientation. Lunch and a continental breakfast will be provided during orientation.

- Bedding (pillow, twin sized sheets and blanket or a sleeping bag) .
- Sunglasses, alarm clock, flashlight, work gloves, calculator, Rand McNally Road Atlas/Map, etc.

## **Greyhound**

---

Avoid over packing and don't use large rigid suitcases that are hard to store in the truck. Check current Greyhound luggage policies when packing. You will most likely be limited to the following:

1 piece of luggage that is placed under the bus (under 50 pounds)

1 carry-on bag (under 25 pounds)

Additional luggage is fee based.
